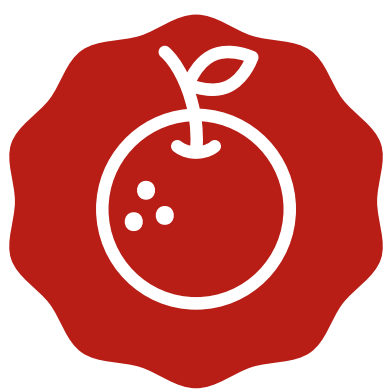


# Friends of Alemany Farm

## 2021 IMPACT REPORT



### **22,000 Pounds of Food. 100% Free.**

Every year, Alemany farmers employ sustainable, ecologically regenerative agricultural practices to produce the maximum *responsible* yield. And everything we grow is offered freely - always.



### **7,500 People Fed.**

Alemany Farmers distribute food weekly through a network of community partners. We maintain an *open harvest* policy, encouraging visitors to "take what you need." Throughout the pandemic, we have seen a 50% increase in community harvest on site.



### **20 Community Partners.**

Rooted in local partnerships, we organize our efforts in close collaboration with other grassroots, community-based organizations. We ally with teams across sectors who, like us, are committed to growing food justice, food sovereignty, and climate resilient neighborhoods in San Francisco.



### **6,020 Volunteer Hours.**

This is the people's farm: Alemany is the second-most volunteered site in SF, after Golden Gate Park (a site 300 times larger). This year, people from all walks of life visited the farm four days a week to steward the land, grow local produce, and give back - safely.



### **6 Paid Apprentices. 15 Interns.**

Youth ages 18-24 train with us year-round to acquire transferable "green jobs" skills. Together, we learn, practice, and teach organic agricultural techniques - empowering local youth to become their own food producers, and preparing them to lead the next generation of food justice activists in the Bay Area.



### **13 Workshops. 464 Participants.**

With topics ranging from seed sowing and propagation, to stewarding native ecologies, to practicing mindfulness in the garden, our workshops are accessible in content and cost, with no one turned away for lack of funds.
